The nut sale is intended to help your Pack, Troop, Crew, Ship, or Post raise funds for your program and adventure needs. It is also a critical part of helping the East Carolina Council meet its financial needs in providing a quality program for your Scouts.

This is a supplemental program to the Annual Council Fall Popcorn Sale. Perhaps there are additional financial needs that your unit and some of your participating Scout families have such as:

- Paying for Summer Camp or Day Camp
- Paying unit dues
- Program fees
- Purchasing new uniforms
- Purchasing equipment needs

Maybe there is a special event like:

- High-Adventure trek like Sea Base, Northern Tier, Philmont or Summitt

# **ECC High Adventure Incentive**

Youth can earn a 50% commission by participating in the ECC Nut Sale to be used towards any ECC sponsored High Adventure Trip.

ECC sponsored High Adventure Trips are:

National JamboreeFlorida Sea BaseWorld JamboreeNorthern Tier

- Philmont - Summit-Bechtel Reserve

- Winterfest—Annually

# To Participate:

- Scouts must contact Clark by email to participate at clark.garthwait@scouting.org.
- Scouts are not eligible to participate in any of the other peanut incentives.
- Scouts must indicate participation at the beginning of the sale before selling.
- Scouts that participate will earn commissioner of 50%.
- Commission will be held in an account at the Scout Office.
- Commission can only be used for event registration, uniform supplies from ECC Scout Shop and fees paid directly by the council.
- Funds cannot be used for third party equipment and personal expenses.
- If the Scout decides to not participate in High Adventure Contingent Trip the money is returned to their home unit at the commission rate that the unit received for the sale.
- If the Scout leaves the Scouting America program before using their total funds, the remaining balance will be returned to the unit at commission rate that the unit received for the sale.
- If the unit did not participate in the Peanut Sale the funds will be transferred to the ECC Assistance Fund.
- All events and expenses must be approved by the Scout Executive or the Assistant Scout Executive.

#### **Solo Scout Program**

Youth can still sell peanuts and pay their way through Scouting even if their unit is not participating in the Peanut Sale. The Peanut Sale can help an individual to pay for their way through Scouting by helping to pay for annual registration, uniform, summer camp and other needs.

# To Participate:

- Register by the Google link and for unit select "Solo Scout".
- If youth and families are interested in participating, they will need to contact Clark by email <a href="mailto:clark.garthwait@scouting.org">clark.garthwait@scouting.org</a> before they start selling.

- Youth will only be able to participate in the Take Order Sale.

#### Commission:

- Youth will earn a commission of 35%.
- Commissions from the peanut sale will be sent to the unit to be distributed to the Scout.

#### Set a Goal

Set a goal for your unit and for everyone. Setting a goal gives a personal incentive to strive for and receive a reward at the end. Examples of goals that can be set:

- ★ Need a new Scout Book:
  - Book costs \$24.00.
  - o Earn a 35% commission you would have to sell \$69.00 worth of nuts.
- Pay for my Scouting registration:
  - Annual BSA registration is \$120.00.
  - o Earn a 35% commission you would have to sell \$343.00 worth of nuts.

When we set a goal, and we strive to achieve that goal we feel good about ourselves.

## **Types of Sales**

For the Nut Sale there are options on ways to sell and it is up to the unit to choose the best option or options to gain the most sales. You can:

- Show and Sell Orders: Selling in front of storefronts.
  - Contact your local stores and ask if you can set up a table at their front door and sell Nuts to help fund your next adventure. Think about the stores that you were able to sell popcorn at and ask them if you could set up a Nut booth.
  - Any state mandates, guidelines, and laws must be followed without exception.
  - Show and Sell is a great opportunity for Scouts and Scouting alike; youth can
    practice in-person sales, raise money for their units, spend quality time with one
    another and raise general awareness for Scouting in our communities. Scouts
    give their sales pitch and ask the customers to support their program!!!

#### Take Order:

- This tried-and-true method involves taking the order form to places such as work, school, church, or through the neighborhood to ask if family and friends would like to place an order. Money should be collected at the time the order is placed. Forms should be filled out as completely as possible, so that the Scout (and the unit) know where to deliver the product when it arrives. Be sure to tell your customers when they can expect their product to arrive.
- Parents/Guardians may take a Scout's order forms to their place of work, worship, etc. if policies allow.

#### Wagon Sales:

- Work with your leader in charge of the Nut Sale and sign out a variety of Nuts and go door to door and ask if they would like to purchase Nuts to help you go to summer camp or your next adventure. When they have selected what they would like then go to your wagon and deliver the Nuts to them.
   Make sure to collect the money, fill out your sales sheet, and thank them for the sale.
- Parents/Guardians can also do Wagon Sales at their place of work, worship, etc. if policies allow.



#### Online Sale:

Whitley's Peanut Factory does not have an online option for the Nut Sale but that does not mean you can't. Work with your Parent/Guardian and use contacts, social media, and all electronic forms to create a buzz about your sale. Ask people to help you by purchasing a tin of Nuts and you will add it the councils Helpers & Heroes donation to a teacher, service personnel, firefighter, police officer, medical professional to thank them for what they do.

#### **How to order additional product for the Nut Sale**

**Nuts can be ordered from the council by individual pieces.** Orders can be placed from your cell phone, tablet, or computer. No orders will be taken over the phone or by email at the Council Service Center. Click on the Google Link below or you can go to the East Carolina Council website on the nut page to find the link and order nuts. When your order is available for pick up, we will contact you by email to make arrangements and schedule a time.

#### **Helpers & Heroes Donation**

It is likely that Scouts will receive donations during the sale from customers that either pay extra or do not want the nuts but want to support Scouting. A Scout is "Trustworthy," and the unit is participating in a Council-sponsored fundraiser and will be on its "Honor" to turn these donations into the council. All donations will be pooled together, and a "Helpers & Heroes" donation will be made to a local organization. The unit that has the highest sales will decide where the East Carolina Councils "Helpers & Heroes" donation is distributed.

#### **Return of Nuts**

Units will not be able to return any unsold nuts to the council for credit. Once the item is signed for and the unit accepts responsibility for those nuts. The only item that can be returned is for a defective or quality and that item will be replaced.

#### Payment

At the end of the sale units will need to make their final payment by June 27<sup>th</sup> to the Perry Family Scout Service Center. Units can send a check or call with a credit card and pay over the phone.

# **Selling Suggestions**

The Whitley's Peanut Factory Sale is a great Spring Fundraiser and will make great gifts for Mother's Day, Father's Day or a great snack to take to a baseball game. Use the experience that your unit has learned from selling popcorn and apply those same techniques to the Nut Sale. Make sure that you ask for permission and check for guidelines.

- Set up a table in front of a store.
- ★ Sell at school ask teachers and friends.
- Sell at farmer's market.
- Sell at a boat dock.
- Sell at a fishing store or sporting goods store.
- Sell at a baseball game.
- Sell next to a food truck.
- Sell door to door.
- Sell at your work or place or worship.
