Events: 34 Merit badge sessions will be offered over the course of the weekend, with 11 being Eagle required merit badges.

When: January 16th – 18th, 2026.

Gates will open at 12 noon, on Friday.

Check in will begin at 5:00pm on Friday.

Merit Badge Sessions will start at 8:30 am on Saturday morning.

Registration: Registration – Youth \$30.00 per registered scout if registered by 1/11/26.

Late Registration – Youth \$40.00 per registered scout after 1/11/26.

Saturday only – Youth \$20.00.

Registration – Adult \$25.00 per registered adult if registered by 1/11/26.

Late Registration – Adult \$35.00 per registered adult after 1/11/26.

Saturday only – Adult \$15.00.

Friday night's attendees will receive a BBQ chicken plate included in their registration.

Those adults teaching a merit badge will be **free** of charge.

Registration will open via email on December 8, 2025, at 6:00 am.

Registration closes on 1/11/2026.
